The results will be announced at the Club's Annual meeting held on Saturday, June 4, 2011 at 1:00 pm in the Clubhouse at which time the ballots will be verified and the votes will be counted by a voting inspector. Our annual election of Board members, in accordance with our governing documents, requires a majority of membership participation in the election process.
